**Mourning Glory** by Warren Adler [F/ADL]

Grace Sorrentini, a stunning woman approaching forty who is determined to obtain a secure future for herself and her daughter, adopts a new persona to catch a handsome and rich widower in Palm Beach.

**Claudia's Shadow** by Charlotte Vale Allen [F/ALL]

As her sister's sole heir, Rowena Graham moves into Claudia's house – their old family home and begins to sort out her sister's affairs. There was no note and the suicide verdict feels all-wrong. Rowena is certain Claudia would never have taken her own life.

**Dreaming in Color** by Charlotte Vale Allen [F/ALL]

**All Shook Up** by Susan Anderson [LP/F/AND][F/AND]

Journeying to Star Lake Lodge to claim his half of an unexpected inheritance, street-wise loner J.D. Carver is drawn into the warm hearted orbit of the Lawrence family, including Dru, a young single mother struggling to overcome her "bad girl" reputation.

**The Past is Another Country** by Lois Battle [F/BAT][LP/BAT]

**Circle of Friends** by Maeve Binchy

On the surface, the quiet streets of Knockglen seem to carry the mundane traffic of uneventful lives. Benny, an only child smothered with love from her adoring parents and Eve, the orphan of the convent handyman and a rebellious daughter of the rich Protestant westward family who abandoned her to be raised by nuns, seem an unlikely pair. But they are bonded in the special way of lifelong friends.

**The Copper Beech** by Maeve Binchy

Carved on the trunk of the mighty copper beech that embraces the schoolyard in Shancarrig are declarations of love, hope and identity – the youthful dreams of the children who played there. Then the empathy set out to find the ring that could destroy his futuristic world and he ran into an unexpected setback, a beauty that roused his untested desire.

**The Future Has A Past** by J. California Cooper [F/COO]

Ordinary women search for meaning, love and what is truly important in their lives in a collection of short fiction that includes the story of a single mother who ignores chances to find her own happiness while devoting herself to her selfish children.

**Time and Time Again** by Dennis Danvers [F/DAN]

This novel will forever change your assumptions about the power of love and the limits of imagination. It is a love story that defies the boundaries of time and reason, about a man and a woman whose lives are intertwined, literally, for all time.
